Submitted papers should be in English, double-spaced, maximum length 8,000 words, accompanied by an abstract, up to 5 keywords and JEL classification. The front page of the paper should be anonymous. A separate front page with the name(s), institutional affiliation, and contact address of the main author should be included. An abstract, not exceeding 200 words, should also be included. Submitted papers undergo a double-blind review process. Authors will be informed about the final status of their papers within one month from the date of submission. Submitted papers should contain original unpublished work that has not been submitted for publication elsewhere. If the paper is accepted for publishing, author(s) are asked to comply with the format and style of the journal (see the *Guidelines for Authors* available at <http://www.eizg.hr/en-US/Croatian-Economic-Survey-26.aspx>)
